- Policies and Procedures -

Registration

Registration is \$200.00 per camper

Registration is due ONCE A YEAR for all Lazy Acres campers. All registration fees are non-refundable.

Hours of Operation

Camp Hours: Monday - Friday, 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM

Extended Camp Hours Monday - Friday: 7:30 AM to 5:30 PM

Office Hours: by phone/email Monday - Friday 8:00 AM - 5:00 PM

No parents are allowed on campgrounds without an appointment, so please call or email to schedule a tour.

Registration Forms and Weekly Fees

Payment and all required forms are due no later than the end of the day Wednesday before your child's week of attendance. A \$30.00 late fee per child will be charged to your child's account if the payment is not received by the Wednesday before attendance. If we have not received a payment by Monday, your child **will not be permitted to attend camp**. Once payment is made, your child is welcome to return to camp! No refunds are allowed. If your child is sick, you may exchange your days with a doctor's note and camp approval. Please contact the office by email at camp@lazyacresevents.com for details and approval.

To complete registration, please: complete online forms, upload your camper's shot records or notarized exemption affidavit, initial & sign where indicated, and submit at least ONE WEEK before camp begins. Per state requirements, campers cannot attend without a current immunization record or a notarized exemption affidavit.

Payments & Fees

Cash and checks are only accepted on-site. To receive the \$5 cash payment discount, it must be turned in on time (Wednesday before camp starts). Checks must have your Child's name and week of attendance written in the memo; **please make checks payable to Lazy Acres**. A fee of \$30.00 will be charged for NSF checks. After Lazy Acres receives two NSF Checks for payment, you must pay by cash or credit card. All credit card payments are made through our website. To make a credit card payment, go to lazyacresevents.com and click on the payments icon on the Summer Camp tab.

Dismissal

We reserve the right to dismiss campers with no refund in the event of behavioral problems that may put the safety and well-being of Lazy Acres campers and/or staff at risk.

Illnesses

Children with fever or illness must be picked up within **ONE HOUR** of contacting parent/guardian. Pickup after one hour will incur late pickup fees. All illnesses must be communicated to camp staff to ensure the effective care of campers. Campers with contagious illnesses are required to stay home from camp until a medical Doctor gives written notice that their illness is no longer contagious. No refunds are allowed. If your child is sick and misses more than one day, you may exchange your day(s) with a doctor's note and camp approval. Please contact the office by email at camp@lazyacresevents.com for details and approval.

Camper Sign In and Pick Up

The entrance gate to SIGN IN campers opens at 7:30 for extended hours; please do not show up earlier as it causes traffic to back up on Stagecoach Rd. The Gate closes for camper's safety at 9:30 and will reopen at 3:30. PARENTS MUST SIGN IN THEIR CAMPERS EVERY MORNING and must stay in their cars and join the pick-up line for camper pick-up. Please call if you plan to pick up your camper between 9:30 - 3:30 when the gate is closed.

Late Pick-Up Fees

Camp ends at 4:30 PM or 5:30 PM sharp for extended hours. Please call to inform our closing staff if you are running late. A fee is applied for each camper picked up after 5:30. *Late fees are per child.* Late pick-up fees are \$1 per minute late. Ex. 5:05pm = \$5 per child; 5:17pm = \$17 per child

Lazy Acres Camp Merchandise

Campers must bring their LASC gear daily. LASC Merchandise pickup is every Monday morning from 8:00 AM – 9:00 AM, starting the first week your camper attends. If you need extra or replacement gear, additional merchandise can be purchased at the sign in desk. Thank you for making sure your camper is fully equipped for a great time at Lazy Acres Summer Camp!

Sunscreen

Campers are required to arrive at camp **with sunscreen already applied** each day. Since campers spend several hours outdoors before lunch, this initial application is essential.

- **Personal Sunscreen:** If your child has specific sunscreen needs, you may send their personal sunscreen in their **LA backpack**.
- **Reapplication:** Lazy Acres will provide sunscreen for reapplication at lunchtime. However, fair-skinned or sensitive-skinned campers are encouraged to keep their own sunscreen in their backpacks and can apply it themselves or ask for assistance.
- **Rashguard:** Campers are required to wear their LA rashguard during water activities.

Items From Home

Campers are permitted to bring books, lunch, snacks, small blankets, small pillows, and one stuffed animal. NO ELECTRONIC DEVICES. Please put your **child's name on all belongings**. We cannot guarantee the safekeeping of extra items and are not responsible for the loss or damage of items. Counselors will let Campers know when they can use items brought from home. It is understood these items may be confiscated if the privilege is misused. Campers are not allowed to bring or carry pocket knives or weapons of any kind. Parents/guardians who are unsure about an item should ask a staff member. Lazy Acres staff reserves the right to look through camper items if deemed necessary by the Camp Director.

Labeling Policy

We will attempt to return all labeled items. Please label all LASC-required gear with a permanent marker on the label spot under "this item belongs to." Many children have the same swimsuits, shorts, and shoes. Lost and found shelves are located near the sign-out table; **please check for lost items every Friday**. If items are not claimed by the last day of camp, they will be donated or discarded.

Cell Phone/Electronic Device Use

Cell phones and Electronic Devices are not allowed at camp. If your child brings either to camp, it must stay concealed within their bag inside their cubby. Any camper caught using their device without prior authorization from a Lazy Acres staff member will have their device confiscated. The device will be released to the parent at pickup.

Lunch and Snacks

Campers may bring their own prepared lunch and three snacks, or choose to have **SG Farmhouse** provide their lunch for **\$60 per week** (Monday-Friday). Lunch must be ordered online or at the sign-in desk **before camp starts on Monday morning**.

If your child brings their own lunch, please make sure it is a well-balanced meal with three protein-packed snacks. Please note, we cannot microwave items for campers. Many campers find that they don't have enough food, so be sure to pack more than usual to keep them full throughout the day. Some snack ideas include: ½ sandwich, cheese/crackers, fruit, yogurt, protein bars, etc. Small soft coolers are encouraged.

If a camper forgets their lunch, **SG Farmhouse** will provide one for a **\$12.00 fee**. An invoice reflecting any charges will be emailed or sent home with your child. Thanks for helping us ensure your child has enough to eat during their busy day at camp!

Concessions

Lazy Acres will open our concession stand at scheduled snack and lunch times for campers to purchase drinks, snacks, and treats for \$1 - \$3. Snacks and Gatorade are \$2 and include (but are not limited to) chips, beef jerky, gushers, fruit roll-ups, and crackers. Candy is available for \$3. Please send your child with cash if they plan to purchase concessions.

Nut Allergy Awareness

Any food or nut allergy must be **written and verbally** reported to the Lazy Acres Assistant Director or Director. We do not accept any liability for nut allergies, as **we do not guarantee a nut-free facility**.

Dress Code

Lazy Acres RASH GUARD must be worn every morning on top of camper's swimsuits with athletic shorts. As an indoor/outdoor activity-based Christian program, we ask that all campers wear age and activity-appropriate clothing. Some required dress code items are tennis shoes, water shoes, no exposed undergarments, no exposed midriff, shorts to mid-thigh, one piece or tankini swimsuits for girls, and drawstring trunks with lining for boys and their LASC rashguards. Campers violating the swim dress code will not be permitted to participate in swim time.

Discipline Policy

We use positive techniques of guidance, including logical consequences applied in problematic situations, redirection to more acceptable behavior, anticipation and elimination of potential problems, and encouraging appropriate behavior and positive reinforcement. Our goal is to help children become self-directed in their behavior.

Inclement Weather

For the safety of our campers, outdoor and water activities will be paused until 30 minutes have passed without lightning in the area. Lazy Acres follows National Weather Service guidelines for severe weather warnings, including flooding, hurricanes, and tropical storms. If Lone Star College - Tomball closes due to weather, Lazy Acres will also close. For the **latest updates** and announcements, please check our **camp Facebook page**. Stay safe, and thank you for your understanding!

Swimming Pool

All campers are required to take a state mandated swim test, which can be somewhat challenging for our younger campers. Campers must be able to jump from the edge into the deep end, climb out of the pool without the use of a ladder, and swim the length of the pool and back twice before swimming without a life jacket. If your child does not pass the swim test, they must bring a US Coast Guard-approved life jacket to wear in the pool, and they must always wear their life jacket while in the pool area. If you are concerned that your camper may require a life jacket, please send them to camp with one on their first day; we will send the lifejacket home if your camper passes the swim test. If you prefer that your child NOT attempt the swim test, please include that information on your registration forms. Any camper with hair to their shoulders or longer must have their hair pulled back while swimming for safety.

Head Lice and Nit Policy

At Lazy Acres, we are dedicated to providing a healthy and safe environment for all campers. Because children play in close quarters, head lice can spread quickly and are difficult to eliminate. To help prevent lice, we ask parents to check their child's head before camp begins. We strictly enforce a NO NIT POLICY—if a camper is found with lice or nits, they will be sent home for treatment. Before returning to camp, campers must be cleared by the Lazy Acres director. If treatment was provided by a professional service, campers may return with proof of receipt.

Thank you for your cooperation in keeping **Lazy Acres a clean, safe, and enjoyable space for all campers!**

- 2026 Required Daily Camp Checklist -

To ensure your child(ren) will be able to participate in ALL activities, we request they bring the following:

- Bottle of WATERPROOF aerosol sunscreen to keep in their backpack
- LASC Backpack - stays with your child all day, every day! Pack their LA T-shirt, their sunscreen, and flip-flops in their backpack.
- LASC T-shirt
- LASC Rash Guard
- LASC Sports Water Bottle – gets refilled throughout the day at camp.
- Tennis Shoes – A must **EVERY DAY** for all outdoor activities
- Bathing Suit – Campers must come in their swimsuits every morning, with appropriate camp shorts and LASC camp Rash Guard (you can purchase extra rash guards and t-shirts at our merch station at check-in). **** Please pack a large labeled ziplock with dry clothes. Wet suits will be sent home in a ziplock.**
- LASC Beach Towel - Can be left at camp Mon-Fri (sent home Friday for cleaning)
- Flip Flops/Water shoes - (There are stickers in the grass, and outdoor surfaces are hot) Put in their backpacks.
- US COAST GUARD APPROVED Life jacket- **REQUIRED** for children who do not pass swim tests, choose not to take one, or are not strong swimmers. (Life jackets will have an official USCG label if they are Coast Guard-approved.)
- Mat/Pillow/Blanket – **The state of Texas requires all children to have at least a 1½ hour rest period after lunch.** Children 8 years old and under lay down to watch movies. (they get tired!) Please send a *labeled, personal-size* nap mat/blanket and a small pillow. (Large blankets and pillows will be sent home.) We will send items home on Friday to be washed. Lazy Acres can not provide pillows, mats, or blankets. Children 9 years and older watch movies sitting up or play games.
- Sack Lunch or Ordered Camp Lunch for the week – No microwave is available. If your child's lunch needs to be kept cold, please send them a thermal lunch kit. No hard shell cooler-style lunch kits are allowed. Be sure your camper has plenty of food. The weekly camp-provided lunches must be ordered online before camp starts or at the front desk..
- THREE (3) nutritious and protein-packed snacks.
- Bug Spray - If your child is susceptible to insect bites or has terrible reactions, please bring them bug spray with their camp gear. If your child has skin allergies or sensitivity, please plan to provide your own labeled bottle of sunscreen and bug spray.
